

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Greenville Utilities Commission (GUC) will hold a public hearing on the 28th day of July 2008 at 5:30 PM, in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 200 West Fifth Street, in order to consider an adjustment to retail electric rates.

Greenville Utilities' electric supplier, the North Carolina Eastern Municipal Power Agency, is proposing a 14% wholesale electric rate increase to be effective August 1, 2008. To recover these increased costs, the GUC Board of Commissioners will be considering an adjustment of approximately 11.2% for retail customers effective August 1, 2008. The Board will also be considering an amendment to the energy rider language in the electric utility rate schedules to recover system line losses.
