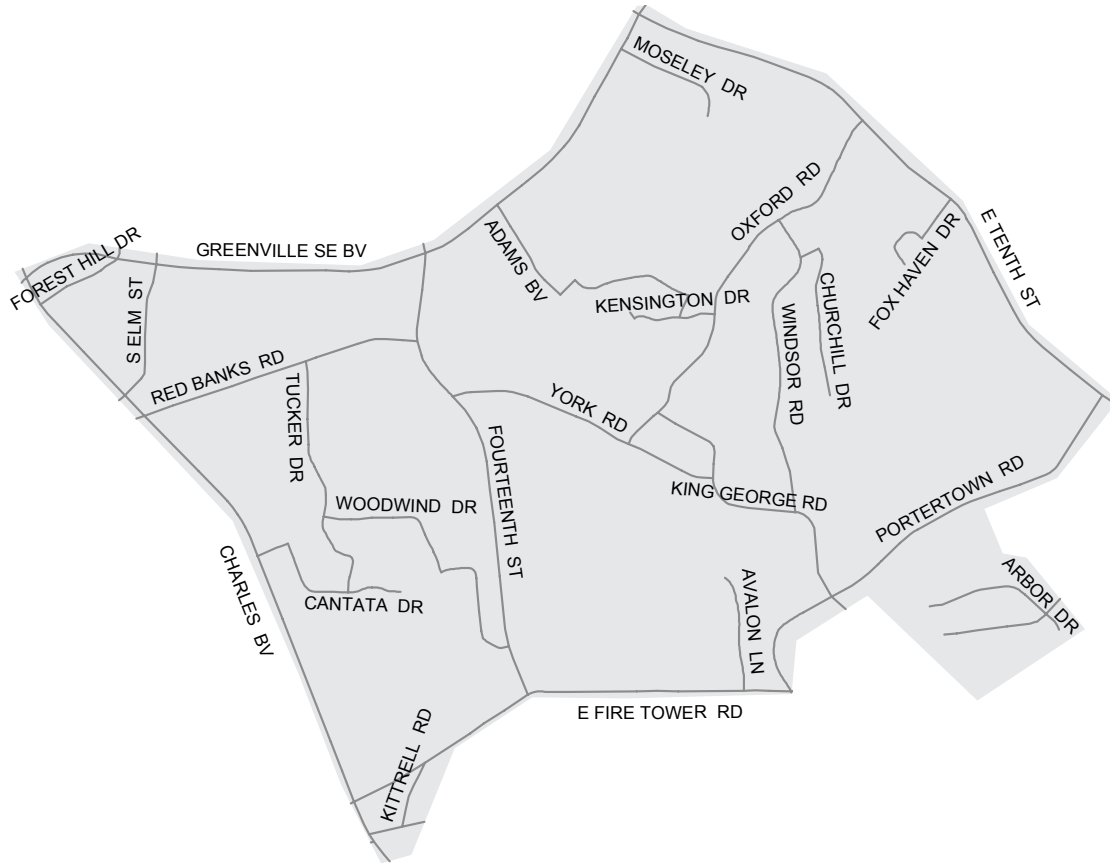


Attention Greenville Utilities Water Customers:

Greenville Utilities will begin the final phase of “Operation Spring Clean” tonight and continue through June 17 in all areas from Greenville Blvd. between Charles Blvd. to Hwy. 33 East to the end of Greenville Utilities’ water distribution system.



“Operation Spring Clean,” is a preventive maintenance program to ensure that GUC customers continue to receive high quality water. During the 13-week program all 616 miles of water distribution lines on GUC’s system will be cleaned. Cleaning involves opening fire hydrants and allowing them to flow freely for a short time. From Sunday evening through Friday morning, cleaning will be conducted during 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., to minimize inconvenience to customers.

If customers have air or discolored water in their water lines as a result of “Operation Spring Clean,” GUC recommends turning on the cold water faucet in the bathtub and running the water for 5 to 10 minutes. Although there is no health risk, GUC advises customers to avoid washing clothes until the water is clear.
