ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE NO. 2

SMALL GENERAL SERVICE

I. AVAILABILITY

This schedule is available for electric service used by a nonresidential customer at a single point of delivery, at one of the Commission's standard voltages, with a Contract Demand of less than 35 kW, until the Customer's registered demand equals or exceeds 35 kW in two consecutive months.

This schedule is not available: (1) for residential service, (2) for resale service, (3) for a Contract Demand of 35 kW or more, or (4) whenever the monthly registered demand equals or exceeds 35 kW in two consecutive months. The Commission may at any time conduct a test or install a demand meter to determine the maximum 15-minute demand.

II. MONTHLY RATE

A. Basic Customer Charge.....\$12.89

B. Energy Charge:

First 1,000 kWh.....	13.177 cents/kWh
Next 5,000 kWh.....	12.558 cents/kWh
All Additional kWh.....	10.696 cents/kWh

C. The minimum charge for service shall be the "Basic Customer Charge."

D. The applicable North Carolina sales tax will be added to all charges listed above, except billings to designated Federal and State agencies.

All Energy Charges are subject to tracking adjustments as might be reflected by NCEMPA's energy rider. The above Energy Charges include a currently applicable adjustment of 0.000 cents per kWh plus an additional adjustment to recover related system losses.

III. PAYMENTS

Bills are due when rendered, and subject to a 1% penalty if not paid by the due date. For additional information, refer to Utility Regulations, Part D, Customer Service Policy.

IV. TERM OF CONTRACT

Open order, unless the Customer, or the Commission requests a written contract.
In such case, the term of contract for the purchase of electricity under this schedule shall be such as may be mutually agreed upon, but not less than one year.
