ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE NO. 3-ECD

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RIDER

I. APPLICABILITY

The Commission's wholesale power supplier, the North Carolina Eastern Municipal Power Agency (NCEMPA) offers for the benefit of its participants Economic Development Rate (EDR) Riders to its All-Requirements Bulk Power Supply Rates. These EDR Riders provides for discounts in the Commission's wholesale power costs associated with service provided to qualifying new commercial and industrial loads at new premises or qualifying new commercial and industrial load expansions at existing premises.

Eligibility of new loads or expansions for consideration of such discounts by NCEMPA shall be subject to those requirements and conditions specified by NCEMPA under each EDR Rider and is subject to prior review and approval by NCEMPA.

To the extent that the Commission is able to receive such discounts in wholesale cost of power under the provisions of NCEMPA EDR Riders, the Commission shall provide the Customer with credits toward the Customer's monthly retail charges for electric service or other considerations toward the provision of electric service of equal monetary value to any discounts received.

To qualify for such credits or other considerations, the Customer must fully comply with all applicable requirements enumerated under these NCEMPA EDR Riders. Additionally, the Customer must fully comply with any additional Commission requirements enumerated and mutually agreed upon by separate agreement.

A copy of NCEMPA EDR Riders shall be provided upon request.

II. TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of contract for receipt of credits of this rider shall be as defined under Definition of Contract Period of each NCEMPA EDR Rider, subject to the continued availability of the EDR Riders and the Customer's continued eligibility under the EDR Riders.
