ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE No. 12

OPTICAL NETWORK UNIT SERVICE

I. APPLICABILITY

This schedule is applicable exclusively to Carolina Telephone and Telegraph Company (CT&T), or its successors, Optical Network Units (ONU). Those devices applicable for this service shall be limited to only those device types expressly identified below and approved in separate agreements between CT&T and the Commission.

Energy consumption associated with these devices shall be assumed fixed at the levels indicated below. These quantities are subject to periodic review and adjustment by the Commission as deemed necessary based upon random metering of these devices by the Commission.

Service shall only be provided to these devices at 120 volts, single phase.

II. MONTHLY RATE

A. Basic Customer Charge: \$1.29

B. Energy Charge:

C. The minimum monthly charge for service to each installation shall be the sum of A and the applicable energy charge for the installation type as referenced in B above. Future adjustments in these charges will be made in accordance with the Commissions standard rate making practices. The basis for future adjustments shall be the Basic Customer Charge, divided by 10, and the energy rate for the first block of kWh purchases associated with Electric Rate Schedule No. 2, Small General Service.

D. The applicable North Carolina sales tax will be added to all charges listed above.

All Energy Charges are subject to tracking adjustments as might be reflected by NCEMPA's energy rider. The above Energy Charges include a currently applicable adjustment of 0.000 cents per kWh plus an additional adjustment to recover related system losses.

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Service shall only be provided to those device installations at mutually agreed upon locations; such locations shall normally be immediately adjacent to the Commission's distribution transformers that will be providing power to the devices. Service will only be provided under this schedule where Commission facilities suitable to provide 120 volt, single phase voltage are currently present to serve other Commission customers.

CT&T shall be responsible for all costs to be incurred by the Commission to provide service to these devices. Such costs shall be paid prior to connection of service.

CT&T shall be fully responsible for notifying the Commission of any changes in the power requirements for these devices which may alter energy consumption assumptions utilized in the development of this schedule. The Commission shall not be obligated to provide service to any devices not fully conforming to the requirements of this schedule or other agreements.

IV. PAYMENTS

Bills are due when rendered, and subject to a 1% penalty if not paid by the due date. For additional information, refer to Utility Regulations, Part D, Customer Service Policy.

V. TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of contract for this service shall be as mutually agreed upon in separate agreements.
