WATER RATE SCHEDULE W-1  
IN-CITY

I. APPLICABILITY

This Water Rate Schedule is applicable to all water customers inside the city limits of Greenville. Mobile home parks and apartment complexes served through master meters shall be classified as residential. This schedule is not applicable to customers outside of the city limits of Greenville.

II. METER READING AND BILLING

Each water meter shall be billed separately. Compound meters, or parallel turbine meters used in lieu of compound meters, shall be billed by combining reading of both registers. Split billing of water meters will not be permitted.

III. MONTHLY CHARGE

The monthly charge shall be the sum of the Base Facilities Charge and the Volume Charge as follows:

1. Base Facilities Charge: The monthly Base Facilities Charge for each metered service, regardless of volume usage, shall consist of a meter charge based on the size of the customer's meter.

(a) Meter Charge

| 1-1/2"            | \$18.63               | 8"                | \$325.94              |
| 2"                | \$29.47               | 10"               | \$524.86              |
| 3"                | \$64.16               | 12"               | \$777.43              |

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2. Volume Charge

The monthly Volume Charge shall be based on the monthly metered water usage by customer class (a) Residential (b) Commercial (c) Industrial, at the following rates per hundred cubic feet (ccf) or per thousand gallons:

(a) Residential - \$3.08 per thousand gallons

(b) Commercial - \$2.49 per thousand gallons

(c) Industrial - \$2.33 per thousand gallons

IV. Conservation Rate (To be implemented at a later date.)

A Conservation Rate of \$4.57 per thousand gallons will be charged for that portion of a customer's usage that reaches or exceeds four (4) times the average winter consumption. This rate is applicable to residential and irrigation customers during the months of June through September. The average winter consumption for residential customers is defined as the average October through February usage for residential customers by meter size. The average winter consumption for irrigation customers is defined as the average October through February usage by meter size for all customers.

V. MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the Base Facilities Charge.

VI. PAYMENTS

Bills are due when rendered, and subject to a 1% penalty if not paid by the due date. For additional information, refer to Utility Regulations, Part D, Customer Service Policy.
