



# Who We Serve: Electric

Our service area has expanded over time and there is not a clear-cut answer to the question, “Who do we serve?” There are many variables in how that question would be answered. Some of our customers receive all our services: electric, natural gas, water and wastewater. Some receive only electric or only natural gas. Some receive electric, water and wastewater. The combinations are unique to the customer and the customer’s location.

Greenville Utilities provides electric service for all of Greenville and 75% of Pitt County. Specifically:

- To the north, we provide electric service to the outside of Bethel, but not Bethel itself, which is served by Dominion Power or Edgecombe-Martin County Electric Membership Corp. (EMC).
- We serve the area northwest of Greenville, including Belvoir and Falkland. Farmville and Fountain are served by their respective towns.
- The area between NC 33 and NC 43 near Belvoir is served by Edgecombe-Martin EMC.
- We serve the Stantonsburg Road and Frog Level areas, out to Ballards Crossroads.
- To the south, our service area includes the areas around Winterville, but not the town of Winterville itself, which is served by the Town of Winterville. The Town of Ayden serves Ayden. Grifton is served by Progress Energy.
- To the southeast, we serve Calico and all the way to Craven County, including a small area of Craven County.
- Looking east, we serve Simpson and areas around Simpson to Grimesland. Grimesland, however, is served by Progress Energy.
