ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE EL-4

SPORTS FIELD LIGHTING (SFL)

I. APPLICABILITY

This schedule is applicable for electric service used exclusively for Customer-owned lighting systems specifically designed for outdoor athletic fields which are normally used for football, baseball, softball, tennis, races, and other organized competitive sports, subject to applicable provisions of the Commission's Utility Regulations.

This schedule is not available for breakdown, standby, supplementary, or resale service.

II. TYPE OF SERVICE

The types of service to which this schedule is applicable shall be served and metered at the Commission's standard distribution voltage, 7200/12470Y kV, either single-phase or three-phase, except where deemed otherwise impractical by the Commission.

III. EXTENSION OF FACILITIES

The Commission will make the type of service agreed upon available to the Customer, provided the Customer will pay to the Commission the total estimated cost of extending, or increasing, the capacity of the Commission's facilities located on the Commission's side of the point of delivery, exclusive of the entire cost of the meter installation. The Customer shall own and be responsible for the cost of installation and maintenance of all facilities beyond the point of delivery.

IV. MONTHLY RATE

- A. Base Facilities Charge..... \$21.00
- B. Demand Charge (All kW)\$2.00 per kW
- C. Energy Charge (All kWh)8.677 ¢ per kWh

D. Sales Tax Charge: The applicable North Carolina sales tax will be added to all charges listed above, except billings to Federal and State agencies.

E. Purchase Power Adjustments: All energy charges include a Purchase Power Adjustments charge set forth in the Electric Rider RR-4, Purchase Power Adjustments (PPA).

V. BILLING DEMAND

The Billing Demand shall be the maximum kW registered or computed, by or from Commission's metering facilities, during any 15-minute interval within the current billing month.

VI. BILLING

The billing to Customer will be continuous from the beginning to the end of each complete season, or period of special use, and service will not be disconnected until the end of each complete season or period of special use. If the season or period of use is for less than 30 consecutive days, Customer will be billed the estimated cost of connecting and disconnecting service,

VII. PAYMENTS

Bills are due when rendered, and subject to a 1% penalty if not paid by the due date. For additional information, refer to Utility Regulations, Part D, Customer Service Policy.

VIII. TERM OF CONTRACT

The Contract Period shall not be less than one month, unless Customer agrees to pay the estimated cost of connection and disconnection.
