

## GREENVILLE UTILITIES COMMISSION

### WASTE SURCHARGE SCHEDULE S-2

#### I. APPLICABILITY

This Waste Surcharge Schedule shall apply to all persons discharging wastes into the sanitary sewer system, where the waste has an average CBOD in excess of 250 ppm, and/or average Total Suspended Solids in excess of 250 ppm, and/or average Total Nitrogen in excess of 40 ppm, and/or average Total Phosphorus in excess of 5 ppm, in accordance with the Commission's Sanitary Sewer use Regulations.

#### II. SEWER CHARGE

The Sewer Base Facilities Charge and the Sewer Volume Charge shall be billed in accordance with Sewer Rate Schedule S-1. The Waste Surcharge will be billed in addition and as a separate charge from the Sewer Service Charge and the Sewer Volume Charge.

#### III. Surcharge Rates

The Surcharge Rate for CBOD in excess of 250 ppm shall be \$0.1621 per pound. The Surcharge Rate for Total Suspended Solids in excess of 250 ppm shall be \$0.2393 per pound. The Surcharge Rate for Total Nitrogen in excess of 40 ppm shall be \$0.8734 per pound. The Surcharge Rate for Total Phosphorus in excess of 5 ppm shall be \$5.2678 per pound. Surcharges will be based on 93.5 percent of measured water consumption, or on 100 percent measured wastewater discharged where separately metered. These rates shall be applied to both in-city and out-of-city users.

#### IV. DETERMINATION OF CHARACTER & CONCENTRATION OF WASTES

The Commission shall determine the character and concentration of waste as necessary for calculating monthly surcharges, as provided in the Sanitary Sewer Use Regulations. Once the concentration of waste has been established they will remain constant for purposes of billing waste surcharge, until such time as processes are changed and additional sampling and analysis of wastes warrant revisions of concentration levels.

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V. PAYMENTS

Bills are due when rendered, and subject to a 1% penalty if not paid by the due date. For additional information, refer to Utility Regulations, Part D, Customer Service Policy.
