

Greenville Utilities is pleased to let you know that we are offering local businesses a rebate on Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) / Plug-In Electric Vehicle (PEV) Charging Stations.

As you know, because the demand for electric vehicles is growing, more companies are producing them every year. With that growth, comes the need for businesses to offer their customers the benefit of a place to charge up while they do business, or to charge company vehicles.


We want to help make that transition a little easier.

Eligible GUC customers include businesses, educational institutions, multi-family dwellings, non-profit organizations, and local governments.

Approved customers receive a rebate of up to \$1,000 for installing a single port, or up to \$1,500 for a dual-port charging station on their property. The total rebate is limited to four stations per customers.

Does GUC pay for and install the charging station(s)?

The customer covers all costs associated with obtaining and installing the charging stations. GUC provides rebate after all work is completed and inspected.

How much does a charging station cost? Costs vary by type and manufacturer of equipment.

Where can I place the charging station?

The EVSE may only be installed at an GUC-approved location, determined during the planning of the project. It must be placed in a well-lit and safe location, in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The spaces will need to be marked with "Plug-In Electrical Vehicle Use Only" signage.

Who pays for the electricity and maintenance of the EVSE?

The customer is responsible for the cost of the energy used, maintenance, repair, and data connectivity. Energy used by the PEV will be included in the customer's monthly electricity bill.

Can I get a rebate for installing a station at my home?

The rebate is only for businesses, educational institutions, multi-family dwellings, non-profit organizations, and local governments. Residential customers are not eligible for the rebate.
