Discussions, questions and answers:

#1 Which is more important, engine horse power or PTO horse power.? We replied that the engine horse power was the most critical and that both horse powers were minimums, and slightly higher is acceptable as long as we maintain the same class of tractor. No changes needed on specifications.

#2 Are stabilizer cylinder guards required? We replied yes. No changes needed on specifications.

#3 Clarification on 4 way loader valve on page 5 under "Three Point Hitch". 4 way loader valve should be listed on page 5 under "Loader" on specifications.

#4 Add to page 6 under "Required Options", Working Lights- add two forward facing and two rear facing work lights. Headlights can substitute for forward facing lights.

#5 Add to page 6 under "Required Options", Canopy- add cannot be plastic or fiberglass, must be steel or diamond plate.
