There was a review of the bid document with the below questions, comments and suggestions.

Q&A's

- 1- **GENERAL;** Are these exact or minimum specifications. **These are minimum requirements unless otherwise specified.**
- 2- Page 6, **TV HIGH CUBE BODY CONTROL ROOM INTERIOR TO INCLUDE;** Armstrong Safeguard Hydro no longer available. **Equal quality floor covering acceptable.**
- 3- Page 7, **P&T ZOOM M/C COLOR CAMERA;** Are the numbers to the left quantities? If so, should they not all be the same? **Camera qty. is two (2) each equipped with items listed under section P&T Zoom M/C Color Camera.**
- 4- Page 7, **BRASS COMP STEERABLE CAM TRANS, WHEELED;** Is two speed manual shift on camera carrier a requirement? **Two speed or variable speed controlled from the operator station.**
- 5- Page 8, **COMBINATION TV TRANSMISSION & TOW CABLE ASSEMBLY TO INCLUDE;** 1000'- Multi Conductor Kevlar cable rating states 2000 lb. here and 5000 lb. on page 19. 5000 lb. rating not available in Kevlar cable. Should they all read 2000 lb. rated? **Yes**
- 6- Page 8, **ELECTRIC MOTOR DRIVE TELEVISION CABLE REEL TO INCLUDE;** Is Auto Payout mandatory? **Yes**
- 7- Page 11, **BODY CONTROL ROOM;** Are metal cabinets mandatory or can they be the same material as the operators control station? **Metal cabinets are mandatory.**
- 8- Page 17, **PROFESSIONAL VIDEO FOOTAGE & DATA GENERATOR;** In several areas you requested outdated hardware such as "Parallel Printer Output" and "Ink Jet Driver". Is this needed or should it read newest and latest technology available? **All shall be of the newest and latest technology available.**
- 9- Page 20, **SELF-PROPELLED WHEELED COMPACT CAMERA TRANSPORTER-WITH PROPORTIONAL STEERING;** (1200') of cable listed several times throughout specifications, should this be 1000' or leave it at 1200'? **Minimum of 1000'.**
- 10- Page 22, **GENERIC CCTV SOFTWARE SPECIFICATIONS FOR ASSET MANAGEMENT & DECISION SUPPORT SOFTWARE;** To import and view the existing PipeTech video and stored metadata, it will be more cost efficient if existing data is in PACP format. **PipeTech video and stored metadata is in PACP.**

- 11- Page 22, **GENERIC CCTV SOFTWARE SPECIFICATIONS FOR ASSET MANAGEMENT & DECISION SUPPORT SOFTWARE;** NASSCO PACP and MACP version 4.4 is old version. Any software shall be latest certified version, this will be all software listed throughout the specifications.
- 12- Page 24, **DATABASE STRUCTURE AND REQUIREMENTS;** The Collected CCTV survey data shall be stored in either Microsoft Access, SQL, or Oracle tables, and be available for use by the system owner. Refer to Addendum I.
- 13- Page 28, **GIS AND GPS REQUIREMENTS;** Outdated files listed. ArcGIS 10.1 or newer required.
- 14- Page 28, **GIS AND GPS REQUIREMENTS;** Concerns identified with what the company needs to provide as far as interfacing with our system or systems? They need to know exactly what we have and the support they will receive from our I.T. department in order to provide an accurate quote. This will need to be discussed in tomorrow's meeting. IT will give the support required to facilitate the integration of the software.
- 15- Page 32, **INSTRUCTIONS AND TESTING;** Items listed as needed to have instruction in needs to include software. Can this be taught in the number of days listed or will this need to be listed as separate training with additional days? Refer to Addendum I.
