Questions and Answers for #17-29 RFQ for Bond Counsel

1. Question:

Section 1(b) of the City of Greenville (the “City”) and the Greenville Utilities Commission (“GUC”) – Bond Counsel Joint Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”) requires an acknowledgment that the respondent and respondent’s key professionals are licensed to practice law in North Carolina and are members in good standing with the North Carolina State Bar. The Norton Rose Fulbright team that we would propose to serve as bond counsel to the City and GUC (the “Greenville Team”) will include attorneys that are licensed to practice law in North Carolina and are members in good standing with the North Carolina State Bar. However, the professionals that we consider the “key professionals” of the Greenville Team are not currently licensed to practice law in North Carolina. One or more of the “key professionals” of the Greenville Team are in the process of becoming members of the North Carolina State Bar. Will this set of circumstances meet the requirements of Section 1(b) of the RFQ?
