<u>Response:</u> Full WTP shutdowns will be limited to 6 hours and need to be scheduled in advance with the Owner to coordinate with WTP production. Detailed construction sequencing and maintenance of plant operations during construction will be developed during project design in collaboration with the Owner, Design Engineer, and CMAR.

5. Will the 2- or 3-dimensional models that were created for the PER be made available?

<u>Response:</u> CAD or Revit models of proposed facilities are not available at this time to distribute to potential CMAR firms.

Response: The presentation was distributed to registered CMAR firms
