- 1.) The RFP says :Integrate with Oracle Enterprise Business Suite"- Please advise what specific items should be priced for integration? What are the touch-points and direction of integration? **A two-way sync of inventory will be needed with EBS.**
- 2.) The RFP says :“Fleet software vendor must provide onsite training support prior to and during the process for an extended period of time.” - Please clarify an extended period of time for what should be included in the proposal. **Fleet software vendor should provide onsite training 2 weeks prior to go-live and 2 weeks after go-live. This should be plenty of time for our employees to learn and understand the application.**

Question(s): How many assets do you have that meet the following definitions:

Active parent assets that are being maintained and tracked in the software. **564** Which are defined as originally valued at \$5000 or greater and active. **431** These assets are the parent piece of equipment and not a child asset. A child asset is any asset, regardless of cost, that is either permanently or temporarily attached to another piece of equipment. Examples of child assets are; radios, generators, plows, light bars and so on.- Your Count ???

Active parent asset (do not include child assets in this count either) originally valued at less than \$5000 and more than \$500- Your
