1. When are we supposed to use Min./Hour and Max./Hour?

The min/hour and max/hour values on the proposal form are to capture the min and max salaries of the corresponding position at your company.

2. On page 20 of the notice to award, it references 1,000 hours under Method of Award. Can you please clarify the anticipated volume of work for Overhead and Underground crews? The Specifications call for 2-3 overhead and underground crews, but 1,000 hours would not justify this level of crewing.

The reference to 1000 hours in the "Method of Award" section on page 20 is incorrect. The anticipated volume of work for OH and UG crews is 40 hours per week for 52 weeks (2,080 hours per crew) with the exception of holidays. Please note, this may change if there is a reduction in anticipated workload.

3. Fuel prices are currently extremely volatile. Our contracts with other companies have a fuel clause to balance this risk. Do you intend to implement a fuel clause as part of this contract?
