Sealed Bids for the construction of the indicated project will be received by Greenville Utilities Commission, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read at that time and location. All Bids submitted shall include all required documents as listed in Section 00010 Instructions to Bidders. Bids must be submitted on the printed form, or exact copies thereof, contained in the Contract Documents.

The Work is primarily located at the GUC Water Treatment Plant at GUC WTP 1721 Water Way Rd, Greenville, NC 27834, and consists of the following:

- Replacement of four wedge-wire water supply intake screens (to be furnished by Owner)
- Dredging in the vicinity of the intake screens
- Removal of sand and debris from the two 30-inch raw water pipelines from the intake screens to the pump station wet well

Bids will be received for a SINGLE prime Contract. Bids shall be on a LUMP SUM and UNIT PRICE ITEM basis, with an additive Alternative Bid item as indicated on the Bid Form. The Contract Times for the Work are set forth in the Agreement.

Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any addenda, obtained from a source other than the Issuing Office (Hazen and Sawyer).Each Bidder must show evidence that it is licensed under Chapter 87 of the N.C. General Statutes.

The Greenville Utilities Commission reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.

The Greenville Utilities Commission has adopted a resolution that requires the Commission to solicit minority and women owned businesses to Bid on the Project. The established goals for this project are a 7% goal for minority participation and 4% goal for women participation. Bidders are also required to make good faith efforts to secure bids from Minority and Women Owned Businesses.
