Sealed Bids for the construction of the <u>Bethel Wastewater Pump Station Improvements</u> will be received by <u>Greenville Utilities Commission</u>, at the <u>Greenville Utilities Commission Wastewater Treatment Plant at 240 Aqua Lane, Greenville, NC 27834</u> until <u>3:00 P.M.</u> local time on <u>August 1, 2023</u> at which time the Bids received will be <u>publicly</u> opened and read. The Project consists of demolishing an existing pump station and replacing it with a 360-gpm submersible sewage pump station with approximately 350 LF of 8" force main, construction of a new 960-gpm Main Pump Station with approximately 1,200 LF of 14" force main, demolition of the existing Main Pump Station site, 265 LF of 21" gravity sewer, 41 LF of 10" gravity sewer, and various gravity sewer point repairs throughout the Town of Bethel.

Bids must be submitted on the complete project. All bids must be made on blank forms provided and included in the bound document. The name, address, and license number with limitation and classification of the Bidder must be plainly marked thereon.

Contractors are notified that North Carolina G.S. 87 relating to licensing of contractors will be observed in receiving bids and awarding contracts.
