- 1. Are there any underground facilities?
 - a. There are no underground facilities installed in the substation; however all contractors are obligated to complete locate tickets before excavation can begin.
- 2. Are there any access restrictions?
 - a. The site will be available to the contractor when beginning construction and the contractor will be able to put their lock daisy chained in the gate.
- 3. Are anchor bolts provided?
 - a. Anchor bolts will be delivered on site to the contractor.
- 4. Are the composite oil containment panels to be installed as part of the bid?
 - a. Yes, the contractor is to install the Composolite oil-containment per manufacturer instructions referenced in the specification.
- 5. Is concrete testing required?
 - a. Concrete tested is to be performed per the specifications, section 1.10.
- 6. Are two rings included for the large piers?
 - a. Yes, AB-6 patterns are fabricated with two anchor bolt templates per pier.
- 7. Are oil containment materials provided?
 - a. The Composolite walls, including installation materials will be provided. The SPI oil-stop device receptacle will be provided less pipe to the outflow. Contractor to provide asphalted fiber expansion joint and sealant materials as listed in specifications.
- 8. Are conduits to be installed through the oil containment?
 - a. Conduits will be installed by GUC and stubbed out of the area for the oil containment.
